White Hole

Pink Album

A white hole is the exit of a wormhole, which interfaces two universes. The two universes are represented by Nicholas Bussmann and Hanno Leichtmann. Bussmann is responsible for the first element of this duo, and Leichtmann is the „popsau“ or „Catherine Deneuve of electronica“, like DE:BUG once declared.

Both have been activists in diverse berlinese music connections for a long time and have been cooperating in various formations for the last 10 years – for example „Ich Schwitze Nie“ (with the actor Lars Rudolph, known from the movie „Der Kriger und die Kaiserin“ or at the Maerzmusik Festival in Berlin with John Zorn on his compilation „Cobra“.

Among other things, Bussmann plays with Radian drummer Martin Brandlmayer at Kapital Band 1 (Mosz) and he is collaborating with the Japanese luminary Toshi Nakamura.

Leichtmann connected as Paloma (Mehrwert), Sam Miller (Mosz) and first of all as Static (Mermaid/ Sonar Kollektiv, City Centre Offices) all kinds of pop music. Recently they played together as DJ Attaché & The Beige Oscillator (Mehrwert, Charhizma), but because everyone used to expect a DJ set behind this name, Bussmann and Leichtmann created an unequivocal name for the band: White Hole.

They recorded their „Pink Album“ in Vienna, where Leichtmann lived for 2 month in the beginning of 2004. Bussmann travelled with a hard disc reorder in his suitcase to Vienna, and within two weeks they generated their album, including appearances of the Viennese musicians Boris Hauf (saxophone) und Martin Siewert (guitar).

The result is a round hip hop record, which, with its bouncing beats, forces to nod the head and at the same time includes jazzy elements: this disharmonies are installed productively, sounds get layered and milled again.

The simplest example for this is a free jazz like saxophone solo, which tears the beats apart at one point.
